Types of Materials Accepted <i>* Please separate into these categories for quicker drop-off</i>	How to sort and clean material
<p>Aluminum Cans</p>	<p>Empty cans of contents. Be careful not to mix w/ steel cans <i>* If unsure, use a magnet. It sticks to steel, but not aluminum</i></p>
<p>Aluminum Foil & Pie Plates</p>	<p>Do not mix with aluminum cans</p>
<p>Steel Cans Cans used for soup, dog food, vegetables, etc.</p>	<p>Rinse thoroughly. No spray cans of any kind. Be careful not to mix with aluminum cans <i>* If unsure, use a magnet. It sticks to steel, but not aluminum</i></p>
<p>Plastic Bottles (PETE#1) Used for soda, juice, water bottles, etc.</p>	<p>Look for PETE#1 designator on bottom of container. Rinse & drain bottles. NO TUBS, TRAYS or OPAQUE BOTTLES. DISCARD LIDS</p>
<p>Plastic Jugs (HDPE#2) Used for milk, windshield cleaner, cat litter, liquid laundry detergent, etc.</p>	<p>Look for HDPE#2 on bottom of container. Rinse and drain jugs. NO TUBS, TRAYS or MOTOR OIL CONTAINERS. DISCARD LIDS</p>
<p>Stretchable Plastic Any stretchable plastic, including bags used for groceries, produce, bread, frozen vegetables, and visqueen</p>	<p>Clean, stretchable plastic</p>
<p>Office Paper Computer, white, colored, copy, fax, legal pad, phone message pad, true manila file folders & envelopes, post-it notes, glossy card stock, white envelopes, junk mail, index cards, and bagged shredded</p>	<p>No copy paper wrapping, hanging file folders, blueprints or mustard colored envelopes. Discard "non paper" inserts from junk mail. Staples OK</p>
<p>Mixed Paper Magazines & catalogs, phone books copy paper wrapping, file folders, paperback books, non-manila folders & envelopes, white paper bags, construction paper, yellow craft envelopes, all types of paperboard and poster board</p>	<p>No carbon paper, blueprints, paper cups or plates, wet strength paper, waxed paper, napkins, tissue paper or paper towels, aseptic packages (drink boxes), hard backed books</p>
<p>Newspapers (Paper inserts OK)</p>	<p>No plastic inserts or plastic sleeves. Please do not wrap with twine or tape</p>
<p>Egg Cartons</p>	<p>Clean paperboard or plastic cartons OK for reuse. Flats and torn cartons go in with 'Mixed Paper'</p>
<p>Corrugated Cardboard & Brown Paper Bags</p>	<p>No greasy pizza boxes, no 'waxed' boxes</p>
<p>Packing Peanuts</p>	<p>No contaminated material or rigid styrofoam</p>
<p>Ink Jet Cartridges</p>	<p>Cartridges with a copper strip are accepted <i>* No toner bottles</i></p>
<p>Eye Glasses</p>	<p>Prescription & reading glasses. No broken or scratched glasses</p>
